# **ICSL COMMUNITY**

The International Christian School of Lima is an American university preparatory school, serving international and Peruvian students from age 5 through grade 12. Established in 2001, ICSL is firmly established in the Miraflores District of Lima, Peru, with a current enrollment of 140 students from over 23 different nations. The current HS enrollment is 30 students, with 8 students in the 2024 graduating class. All classes (except foreign languages) are taught in English, and students do have the ability to earn a Peruvian Diploma after completing grade 11.

The 39-person faculty is predominately from the USA, but also includes citizens from Canada, Brazil, South Africa, and Peru. ICSL requires all teachers to have active teaching licenses and prior teaching experience in order to be considered for a position at our school.

# **ACADEMICS & COMMUNITY SERVICE**

- ICSL uses the CCSS, AERO, NGSS, NCAS, WIDA and SHAPE standards from the USA, as the basis for all academic coursework in grades KG-12.
- ICSL purchases curriculum resources from USA curriculum developers for use in all grade levels.
- ICSL provides at least 3 on-site AP courses and offers more than 20 other AP course options through a partner online school called Northstar Academy.
- ICSL requires all students in grades 1-11 to complete a MAP assessment twice a year.
- ICSL requires all non-native English speaking students to complete a WIDA assessment prior to enrollment.
- ICSL requires all students in grade 10 to complete the PSAT assessment.
- ICSL offers the PSAT & SAT assessments to all students in grades 9-12.
- ICSL requires a set number of hours of community service from all students in grades 5-12.

Only classes taken at ICS-Lima or through NorthStar Academy are calculated in a student's GPA. Students receive an extra 1.0 point added to their GPA for AP courses scoring above a C. ICS-Lima does not rank students beyond first and second place.
